

**PURPOSE:** The purpose of this Addendum/NOTICE is to make changes, additions, deletions, revisions, and clarifications to the (ITB) Invitation to Bid documents for Wellington Environmental Preserve Greenway Project. Bidder shall review the Addendum/NOTICE work and requirements in detail and incorporate any effects the Addendum/NOTICE may have in their proposal price.

1. **Question: Will subcontracting to an FDOT pre-qualified contractor for the asphalt installation suffice in place of the prime contractor themselves being FDOT pre-qualified?** No, the primary bidder must be FDOT pre-qualified in the installation of flexible pavement and concrete.
2. **Question: There is no detail for the F Curb. Can you please clarify the thickness of the asphalt pad beneath the curb? Note on sheet C.9. 4" base-rock will be required beneath the F-curb.** An F-Curb detail has been added to the details, please see revision 1, sheet C.2 for additional clarification.
3. **Question: Can item # 21 Bahia Sod's quantity be verified? The sod quantity provided was incorrect. The correct sod quantity is 39,000 SY. Please see the revised schedule of values item # 21.**
4. **Question: Can details or manufacturer make and model be provided for the trash receptacles, benches and bike racks?** Specifications have been added, please see revision 1, sheet C.2 for additional clarification.
5. The bid documents have been updated as follows:
  - a. The submittal checklist was updated to include the FDOT form numbers
  - b. Item no. 21 in the schedule of values has been revised to 39,000 SY
  - c. Appendix G was added to the bid documents that include the required FDOT forms found on the submittal checklist.






