## ORDINANCE NO. 2024-16 1 2 3 AN ORDINANCE OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA'S COUNCIL, 4 AMENDING THE WELLINGTON CODE OF ORDINANCES TO 5 MODIFY CHAPTER 22 - TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES, ARTICLE II. -6 7 PARKING FOR DISABLED PERSONS AND ARTICLE IV. -PENALTIES; **MISCELLANEOUS** PROVISIONS, AS 8 SPECIFICALLY CONTAINED HEREIN; PROVIDING A CONFLICTS 9 CLAUSE: PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE: 10 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 11 12 WHEREAS, the Wellington Council, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority 13 vested in Chapter 316, Florida Uniform Traffic Control Law, Florida Statutes, is amending 14 the Code of Ordinances to be consistent with the process and penalties for unlawful parking 15 16 in the Village of Wellington; and 17 WHEREAS, the Code of Ordinances is being amended to reference the provisions 18 of Section 316.1955, Florida Statutes and the process for an appeal of a parking violation 19 citation with the Palm Beach County Clerk of Court; and 20 21 WHEREAS, Wellington's Council has taken the comments from the public into 22 consideration of the proposed amendments that are the subject of this Ordinance. 23 24 25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF WELLINGTON, **FLORIDA THAT:** 26 27 28 **SECTION 1.** Chapter 22 – Traffic and Vehicles, Article II – Parking for Disabled Persons and Article IV - Penalties, of the Code of Ordinances, Wellington, Florida, is 29 30 hereby amended as specifically provided in Exhibit A. 31 32 **SECTION 2.** Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance conflict with any section, paragraph, clause, or phrase of any prior Wellington 33 ordinance, resolution, or municipal code provision, then in that event, the provisions of this 34 ordinance shall prevail to the extent of such conflict. 35 36 37

**SECTION 3.** Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phase of this ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole, or any portion of part thereof, other than the part so declared to be invalid.
