**A RESOLUTION OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA'S COUNCIL
APPROVING THE LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES PLAN FOR
FISCAL YEAR 2025-26; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, law enforcement services in Wellington are provided by the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office (Sheriff) in accordance with the terms of an agreement between the Sheriff and the Village of Wellington (Village); and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff and the Village entered into a Law Enforcement Services Agreement effective October 1, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff and the Village entered into the Second Addendum to the Law Enforcement Services Agreement effective October 1, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff and the Village entered into the Third Addendum to the Law Enforcement Services Agreement effective October 1, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff and the Village entered into the Fourth Addendum to the Law Enforcement Services Agreement effective October 1, 2025; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to paragraph 2.3B of the Agreement, the District Commander is required to prepare and submit for approval to the Village Council a Law Enforcement Services Plan (LESP) for the upcoming fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the District Commander has prepared a LESP for Council's review and approval, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, Wellington staff has reviewed the proposed LESP and recommends its approval by the Village Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY WELLINGTON, FLORIDA'S COUNCIL
that:

SECTION 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified as being true and correct.

SECTION 2. The Law Enforcement Services Plan attached hereto as Exhibit "A" has been reviewed and is approved by the Village Council for fiscal year 2025-2026.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
