RESOLUTION NO. R2024-43

**A RESOLUTION OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA'S COUNCIL
APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE VISION ZERO ACTION
PLAN TO ELIMINATE TRAFFIC-RELATED FATALITIES
AND SERIOUS INJURIES WITHIN THE CITY; AND
PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, on July 12th, 2022, the Wellington Council adopted Resolution No. 2022-15 which supported the development of a Vision Zero Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, The Wellington Council established that the elimination of traffic fatalities and the reduction of serious injuries due to traffic accidents is a goal of the Village of Wellington; and

WHEREAS, The Wellington Council adopted Vision Zero as the policy for road and traffic safety in the Village of Wellington and directed that near and long-term traffic planning be based on Vision Zero principles. and

WHEREAS, The Wellington Council directed staff to develop a Vision Zero Action Plan for achieving the goals of eliminating traffic fatalities and reducing serious injuries due to traffic crashes through the adoption of a safe system approach for vehicles, bicycles and pedestrians, equitable engineering, enforcement, education, data-driven decision making, and social equity considerations in road safety planning and implementation.

WHEREAS, The Wellington Council directed the Public Safety Committee to review, evaluate, and make recommendations to the Vision Zero Action Plan and related projects and plans to achieve the goals of eliminating traffic fatalities and reducing serious injuries due to traffic crashes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY WELLINGTON, FLORIDA'S COUNCIL that:

SECTION 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified as being true and correct.

SECTION 2. The Wellington Council hereby approves the adoption of the Vision Zero Action Plan as set forth in Exhibit "A".

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.


