Additionally, the amendment furthers the 18 intent of Wellington's current vision and future needs; and 19 20 WHEREAS, the amendment does not change the intent of the Land Use & Community 21 22 Design Element of the Comprehensive Plan; and 23 24 WHEREAS, the Planning, Zoning and Adjustment Board, sitting as the Local Planning Agency, after notice and public hearing on November 20, 2024, recommended __ 25 Comprehensive Plan Amendment to Table LU&CD 1-1 Land Use Designations: Density and 26 Intensity Plan, along with Policies LU&CD 1.3.3 and 1.4.1, with a ___ to ___ vote; and 27 28 29 WHEREAS, Wellington's Council has taken the recommendations from the Local Planning 30 Agency, along with the Finding of Fact by staff, into consideration for the proposed amendment to the Comprehensive Plan subject to this ordinance; and 31 32 WHEREAS, Wellington's Council, after notice of public hearing. 33 vote to transmit this proposed amendment to the Florida Department of Commerce in compliance 34 with the applicable provisions of the Florida Statutes governing amendments to Local 35 Comprehensive Plans. 36 37 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA 38 THAT: 39 40 SECTION 1. The Land Use & Community Design Element, specifically table LU&CD 1-1 41 42 and policies LU&CD 1.3.3, and 1.4.1 of Wellington's Comprehensive Plan are hereby amended as provided in Exhibit A. 43 44 45 **SECTION 2.** The Manager is hereby authorized and directed to transmit this Comprehensive Plan Amendment to the Florida Department of Commerce pursuant to Florida 46 47 Statutes. 48 49 **SECTION 3.** The Manager is hereby directed to amend the Land Use & Community Design Element of Wellington's Comprehensive Plan as illustrated in Exhibit A and to include the adopted 50 date and ordinance number in accordance with this Ordinance and pursuant to the requirements of 51 52 Chapter 163, Florida Statutes.
