## **REQUEST FOR INFORMATION**

Village of Wellington is seeking interested parties to conduct comprehensive maintenance on its industrial biosolids dryer located at its Water Reclamation Facility.

Description of what is required with this request for service and maintenance:

- Maintenance includes furnishing and installing parts for the replacement of scrubber/condenser and thermal fluid expansion tank, replacement of rotor drive sprocket, replacement of rotor thermal fluid swivels, replacement of worn steel compression ring and installation of new packing and seals at both ends.
- Replacement of dryer discharge door seal, replacement of dryer chamber access support bars, replacement of chamber seals, repositioning of dryer rotor, adjustment of rotor drive chain, replacement of rotor drive chain tensioner, and replacement of rotor disc end plate scraper on drive end.
- Replacement of dryer lifting and conveying paddles, installation of a mechanism to support the weight of the piping and reduce the over hung load on the swivel, replacement of fusible link and installation of a custom seal housing behind each bearing and utilize an appropriate seal to prevent and/or minimize leakage.

Interested parties shall:

- Demonstrate that they performed similar work on at least two (2) industrial biosolids dryers with a capacity to treat at least 72 wet tons a day, in the last five (5) years.
- Provide prior experience references to include the facility name, year work was performed, reference name and number, value of the work and dryer manufacturer.
- Submit qualifications for review by the Village of Wellington to the email below or by submitting electronically through the Village of Wellington's bid portal by June 25, 2020 at 10:00am.
- Confirm that they can have all parts on site within ninety (90) days from the date of authorization and must complete the work within one-hundred-twenty (120) days from the date of authorization.

If deemed qualified, site visits will be conducted to allow qualified entities to submit price proposal.
