

WELLINGTON NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing will be held on the Conditional Use Petition described below:

A RESOLUTION OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA'S COUNCIL, PROVIDING FOR A DEVELOPMENT ORDER FOR PETITION NUMBER 2013-16 CU 1, TO ALLOW A CONDITIONAL USE FOR A WIRELESS COMMUNICATION **KNOWN FOR** CERTAIN **PROPERTY** AS WELLINGTON MARKETPLACE, TOTALING 19.49 ACRES, MORE OR LESS, LOCATED AT INTERSECTION OF WELLINGTON NORTHEAST TRACE AND **GREENVIEW SHORES** BOULEVARD. All appeals must be filed in accordance with the applicable provisions of Wellington Land Development Regulations.
