

ADDENDUM NO. ONE

PURPOSE: The purpose of this Addendum/NOTICE is to make changes, additions, deletions, revisions, and clarifications to the (ITB) Invitation to Bid documents for the Water Treatment Plant Renewal and Replacement Project. Bidder shall review the Addendum/NOTICE work and requirements in detail and incorporate any effects the Addendum/NOTICE may have in their proposal price.

1. **Question:** Bidders throughout the country prefer using Durajoint Waterstops, as independent test data shows, Durajoint PVC Waterstops exceed USACE CRD-C 572-74 requirements across the board. Please advise if they will not be acceptable as an "or equal" alternative for this project.
Response: Bidders need to bid on the requirements as set forth in the Contract Documents. Equal products may be considered after receipt of bids and award of project to responsive and responsible low bidder.
2. **Question:** The bid form requires the Contractor's to list an RO OEM on the Schedule of Subcontractors. Please clarify if the required scope of work for the RO OEM is only the supply of RO Train #7 or if the Engineer's intent is to have the RO OEM and not the Contractor perform the specified modifications to RO Trains 2-5.
Response: The Contractor shall utilize an RO OEM for all trains, #2-5 and #7. The RO OEM proposed to perform the work shall be listed on the Schedule of Subcontractors submitted with the Bid Form.
3. **Table of Contents – Technical Specifications:** Remove Section 08415 and 16485. There are no Interior Aluminum Windows and the Variable Speed Drives specification is integrated into a different section.
 - Change the title of Section 06600 to "Fabricated Fiberglass and Fiberglass Grating".
 - Change the Title of Section 10570 to "Covered Walkway and Equipment Cover".
 - Change the number of pages in Section 15440 to "3".
4. **Specification Section 10500:** Remove and replace with the attached.
5. **Specification Section 10800:** Remove and replace with the attached
6. **Plan Sheets HS-25, Section 4:** Remove reference to acoustic tile.
7. **Plan Sheets G-02 thru G-04:** Remove and replace with the attached.

8. **Plan Sheets HS-12, HS-13, HS-14, HS-15, Legend:** Change text to 3-5/8" x 25-gauge metal studs at 24" o.c. and gypsum drywall, greenboard in Locker Rooms and Restrooms. Provide minimum R-11 batt insulation in all interior stud walls and R-15.6 icynene spray foam in all exterior walls located in air conditioned space.
9. **Plan Sheet HS-19 Room Finish Schedule Notes, (3):** Delete "Insulation (R-5) batt shall be provided behind drywall in all exterior locations."
10. **Plan Sheet HS-21:** Delete Elevations of Men's and Women's H/C bathroom sinks.
11. **Plan Sheet HS-29:** Delete Plumbing Notes 3A, 3B, 3C and replace with the following:
 - 3A. Lavatory at H/C stall in Locker Room and H/C Restroom – A/S 9024.004EC.020 with Moen 84550 faucet, ½" hot and cold and 1 ½" waste. Four (4) required."
 - 3B. Lavatory at Locker Rooms – A/S 0643.004.020 with Moen 84550 faucet, hot and cold and 1 ½" waste. Four (4) required."
 - 3C. WC at Locker Rooms and Restrooms – A/S 215FA.004.020, Five (5) required.
12. **Specification Section 01150, 1.06:** Delete this section and replace with the following:
 - "1.06 OWNER CONTROLLED CONTINGENCY: These funds are received for use by the Owner. Suitable documentation will be required."
13. **Specification Section 01019, 1.19:** Add the following to the list of items to be included in each trailer.
 - "Conference Room with table and chairs to accommodate 10 persons."
14. **Specification Section 16000:** Insert "Part 3 – Execution" ahead of paragraph 3.01 on page 16000-15.
15. **Specification Section 01019, 1.28R – Second Paragraph, Second Sentence:** Change "120 days" to "60 days".
16. **Specification Section 01019, 1.28R – Add the following at the end of the first paragraph:**
 - "The period when both Train 5 and Trains 2 – 4 are out of service shall occur between June 1 and December 31."
17. **Specification Section 01019, 1.28T and Plan Sheet F-02:** Add the following words to the specification section and add the following as a note to the plan sheet:
 - "It is anticipated that the new fluoride feed facility will not be located as shown on the plans but, rather, in a position generally adjacent to the existing fluoride feed facility."
18. **Specification Section 01150:** Add the following:
 - "1.08 The Contractor is advised that the Owner may elect to engage the named Control Room console manufacturer to fully build-out the Control Room through use of the so identified allowance account. If such decision is made, the console manufacturer would be fully responsible for all work inside the Control Room exclusive of the structure itself, insulation and drywall. This information is provided for informational purposes only to identify a construction method the Owner may elect to implement for the Control Room. The Contractor shall not assume this method will be utilized in the preparation of the bid."

19. Plan Sheet HS-03: Add the following note:

- "4. The Owner will remove the existing casework and cabinetry."
- Also, note that the existing cabinets to be removed located in the Operator's Lab will not be reinstalled.

20. Specification Section 11250, 1.02, Second Paragraph: Delete the word "refrigerated" from the fifth sentence.

21. Plan Sheet HS-15 and HS-18: Delete and replace with attached HS-15 and HS-18.

22. Plan Sheet E-77: Delete and replace with the attached.

23. Specification Section 01019, 1.28X: Change first word in the first full sentence from "shutdowns" to "software".

24. The attached "Shutdown and Work Sequencing" constraints table, summarizing the work sequencing activities for each unit process listed in Section 01019 1.28 is hereby incorporated into the Contract Documents.

PURPOSE: The purpose of this Addendum/NOTICE is to make changes, additions, deletions, revisions, and clarifications to the (ITB) Invitation to Bid documents for the Water Treatment Plant Renewal and Replacement Project. Bidder shall review the Addendum/NOTICE work and requirements in detail and incorporate any effects the Addendum/NOTICE may have in their proposal price.

1. **Clarify response to Question No. 2 from Addendum No. 1:** The RO OEM is required perform all necessary coordination activities with the membrane supplier including to unload the existing membrane elements and reload the new ones.
2. **An investigatory asbestos study has been completed on the existing fluoride building and is attached to this addendum for bidder reference.**
3. **Specification Section 01150, 1.07-** last sentence: Insert "or approved equal," immediately after "... fabricated and installed by Evans Consoles, 1577 Spring Hill Road, Ste. 450, Vienna, VA 22182,"
4. **Specification Section 01019, 1.03- 4th bullet:** Replace "RO1, Train 1 SS Valves & Motor Operators" with "RO1, Train 1 SS Pipe and Valves & Motor Operators"
5. **Specification Section 02610, 2.01H -** Delete last two sentences.
6. **Plan Sheet RO1-01, Note 6 –** Delete and replace with the following: "Replace all existing Victaulics located above the finished floor level for Trains 2 through 5 with new 316SS Victaulics."
7. **Schedule of Values, Page 22-** Replace the Schedule of Values in its entirety with the attached replacement form
 - Changed Item #2 : Allowance for architectural finish upgrades from \$70,000 to \$90,000
 - Changed Item #4 : Allowance for control room console, furniture and IT equipment from \$70,000 to \$300,000
8. **Article 5 of the General Conditions (Bonds and Insurance):** Remove and replace with the attached.
9. **Article 6.19 (A) of the General Conditions (Contractor's Responsibilities):** Remove all mention of "three (3) year" warranty and replace with "one (1) year". The warranty for this project shall be for a period of one (1) year.

10. **Question: Article 3 Page 5 states as followed: "Be properly licensed to perform work as a General Contractor in the State of Florida, Palm Beach County, and The Village of Wellington." We have a license to perform work in the State of Florida. I would like to know how we can go about bidding this project? Where do I go to register to perform work in Palm Beach County & the Village of Wellington? Is this something that I can do online?**

Response: In order to pull permits in the Village of Wellington, Wellington's Building department requires a Palm Beach County Certificate of Competency and/or State of Florida Department of Business and Professional Regulation License. In addition, the contractor must register with the Village of Wellington. The Village of Wellington's Contractor Registration Packet can be found on Wellington's website (<http://www.wellingtonfl.gov/home/showdocument?id=16154>). Bidders shall be licensed in the State of Florida and/or Palm Beach County and registered with the Village of Wellington Building Department.

ADDENDUM NO. THREE

PURPOSE: The purpose of this Addendum/NOTICE is to make changes, additions, deletions, revisions, and clarifications to the (ITB) Invitation to Bid documents for the Water Treatment Plant Renewal and Replacement Project. Bidder shall review the Addendum/NOTICE work and requirements in detail and incorporate any effects the Addendum/NOTICE may have in their proposal price.

- 1. Question: Section 09800 - 2.04 M. Steel Decking Underside. I suggest applying Tnemec Series 118 Uni-Bond Mastic as a Primer, which is an elastomeric anti-corrosive mastic acrylic. This primer does not have the intense curing stresses as an epoxy or catalyzed material, like the current specified primers. Since the existing steel coatings are peeling in isolated areas, the elastomeric properties will help hold the existing edges tight while they attempt to break loose. In my opinion, this is the best option for the existing conditions. Series 118 needs to be topcoated with either Series 1026, 1028 or 1029 Enduratone(Matt, Gloss, or Semi-Gloss).**

Response: Bidders need to bid on the requirements as set forth in the Contract Documents. Substitution products may be considered after receipt of bids and award of project to responsive and responsible low bidder in accordance with Section 01019, 1.05.

- 2. Question: Section 09800 – 2.04 Q. Hydrofluosilic Acid Containment Area. The Specified Coatings will not be suitable for Chemical Secondary Containment. I've noticed that the facility floods easily which can create moisture vapor transmission issues for slabs on grade. For this reason I suggest the use of an MVT Primer, like Series 241 Ultra-Tread MVT for the floor. Followed by Tnemec Series 201 Epoxoprime on the walls and floor before applying Tnemec Series 270 Stranlok (Fiber Reinforced Epoxy). Finally a finish coat of Tnemec Series 282 Tneme-Glaze. Since Series 282 is an Epoxy, it will chalk and fade prematurely which creates the option for Tnemec Series 290CRU to be applied as a sacrificial coating. Series 290CRU has chemical and UV resistance.**

Response: Bidders need to bid on the requirements as set forth in the Contract Documents. Substitution products may be considered after receipt of bids and award of project to responsive and responsible low bidder in accordance with Section 01019, 1.05.

- 3. Question: Section 09800 – 2.04 R. RO 1 Building Main Train Floor. The Fourth coat is not necessary for the coating system. Only (1) grout coat is needed, which is the third coat.**

Response: Bidders need to bid on the requirements as set forth in the Contract Documents. Substitution products may be considered after receipt of bids and award of project to responsive and responsible low bidder in accordance with Section 01019, 1.05.

4. **Question: Specification 16485 is missing.**
Response: Please refer to item #3 from previously issued Addendum #1 regarding Section 16485.
5. **Question: Are there any specification for Telephone and Data Communications Systems?**
Response: No. Only the specified conduits are included in this project. These devices will be installed at a later date by others.
6. **Question: Are there any specifications for Access Control system?**
Response: No. Only the specified conduits are included in this project. These devices will be installed at a later date by others.
7. **Question: Are there any specifications for Closed Circuit TV and cameras?**
Response: No. Only the specified conduits are included in this project. These devices will be installed at a later date by others.
8. **Question: Specification 16000 2.07 calls for all interior boxes to be Weather Proof Cast Aluminum . Plans call for receptacles and switches in HSP building to be flush mounted. Are 4" x 4" x 1 ½" steel boxes acceptable.**
Response: Specification Section 16000, 2.07 A – Delete and replace with the following: “All interior surface mount outlet and device boxes on exposed conduit systems shall be threaded hub, cast aluminum of the type size, shape and interior depth to suit the respective location. Boxes shall be minimum 1-1/2-inch deep and single or gang type to accommodate the devices noted. 4" x 4" x 1-1/2" deep steel boxes may be used only when concealed inside furred and stud walls. Provide outlet box accessories as required for each installation.”
9. **Question: Can EMT with Steel fitting be used in the HSP building in the Control, Lab, Break Room, Meeting Room and Locker Rooms for Branch power and Lighting circuits?**
Response: Specification Section 16000 2.06 A – Add the following sentence just ahead of the last sentence in the paragraph: “The only exception to the requirements set forth in this paragraph is that EMT with compression fittings may be used when concealed inside furred and stud walls or above concealed ceilings, including acoustic tile.”
10. **Question: Is there an Electrical Symbol Legend Sheet?**
Response: The symbols used on the plans are consistent with ISA, NEC and are industry standard. Additionally, Legends are shown on multiple sheets (E-09, E-11, E-15, E-18, E-22, I-01, I-02 and others).
11. **Question: 16000 2.06A calls for all above grade conduit to be Schedule PVC 40. 16000 3.02 calls for Rigid Aluminum to be installed overhead and exposed. Please clarify.**
Response: Specification Section 16000, 3.02 A – Delete the first sentence and replace with the following: “All above grade conduits in located in areas designated for PVC conduits shall be rigid Schedule 80 PVC.”
12. **Question: E-14 What is the size of the cable tray that is to be removed?**
Response: The cable tray to be removed is reasonably scalable from the plans and is approximately 18-inches wide by 12-inches high.
13. **Question: E-31 What type of cable tray is to be added? Steel. Aluminum, ladder or solid bottom?**

REQUEST FOR PROOF OF WORKERS COMPENSATION INSURANCE OR EXEMPTION

Dear Provider of Services or Goods:

In order to provide services or goods to Wellington, we require that you provide us either proof of workers compensation coverage or proof of exemption.

Employers conducting work in the State of Florida are required to provide workers' compensation insurance for their employees. Specific employer coverage requirements are based on the type of industry, number of employees and entity organization. To determine coverage requirements for a specific employer, the following information is provided by the Bureau of Compliance.

Construction Industry - One (1) or more employees, including the owner of the business who are corporate officers or Limited Liability Company (LLC) members. For a list of the trades considered to be in the construction industry see 69L-6.021 Florida Administrative Code.

Non-Construction Industry - Four (4) or more employees, including business owners who are corporate officers or Limited Liability Company (LLC) members.

Please note: Non-construction industry Sole Proprietors or partners in a Partnership are not employees unless they want to be included on the business' Workers' Compensation Insurance policy and file a form DWC 251 with the Division of Workers' Compensation.

Agricultural Industry - Six (6) regular employees and/or twelve (12) seasonal workers who work more than 30 days during a season but no more than a total of 45 days in a calendar year.

Out of State Employers must notify their insurance carrier that they are working in Florida. If there is no insurance, the out of state employer is required to obtain a Florida Workers' Compensation Insurance policy with a Florida approved insurance carrier which meets the requirements of Florida law and the Florida Insurance Code. This means that "Florida" must be specifically listed in Section 3A of the policy (on the Information Page).

An Extraterritorial Reciprocity clause in the home state's statute allows some out of state Employers to work in Florida temporarily using their home state's Workers' Compensation insurance policy.

Contractors are required to make certain that all sub-contractors have the required Workers' Compensation Insurance **before** they begin work on a project. To see the documentation that is required from a sub-contractor, see 69L-6.032 Florida Administrative Code.

If the sub-contractor does not have Workers' Compensation Insurance for its employees, those workers become the employees of the contractor. If an injury occurs, the contractor is responsible for paying the benefits for the work related injury, illness or fatality.

If you meet the above criteria to be exempt, you **MUST** provide us with one of the following:

- If your business is a sole proprietorship or unincorporated business: provide us a Verification of Automatic Exempt Certificate. This verification is a letter that is issued by the State of Florida Department of Financial Services. To receive a letter from the State, complete the following directions: 1) Call the National Council of Compensation Insurance 1-800-622-4123, Option 5, and ask them for the class code for your type of business. 2) Once you have received this code, call the Department of Financial Services at 1-850-413-1601 and provide them your business name, class code, mailing address, and contact phone number. They will send you the Verification of Automatic Exempt Certificate. 3) Provide us a copy of the Verification of Automatic Exempt Certificate.
- If your business is a corporation (including a professional association or limited liability company), and you are not required to have workers compensation insurance as per the requirements as outlined above, you must provide the Village with a copy of your Florida Division of Workers' Compensation Certificate of Election to be Exempt.

If you are an employer that meets the requirements of workers compensation and needs to obtain coverage, contact your current business insurance agent, or you may use the following resources to locate an agent: www.fuia.com, www.piafl.org/wc-info.pdf, or call (850) 893-8245.

Please be reminded that the furnishing of this information to Wellington is a non-negotiable requirement to perform services for us. Failure to provide this timely may result in either termination of your services or delay of payment for services. 




