The Council of Wellington will hold a public hearing on the proposed Comprehensive Plan Amendment and Rezoning.

AN ORDINANCE OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA'S COUNCIL AMENDING THE FUTURE LAND USE MAP OF THE WELLINGTON COMPREHENSIVE PLAN BY ADDING AND DESIGNATING 20 ACRES, MORE OR LESS, KNOWN AS THE PANTHER RUN ELEMENTARY SCHOOL, AS "COMMUNITY FACLILITIES"; LOCATED ON THE NORTH SIDE OF LAKE WORTH ROAD, APPROXIMATELY 0.66 MILE WEST OF STATE ROAD 7, AS MORE SPECIFICALLY DESCRIBED HEREIN; AUTHORIZING THE TRANSMITTAL OF THE AMENDMENT TO THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY; PROVIDING A CONFLICTS CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

AN ORDINANCE OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA'S COUNCIL, APPROVING A REZONING TO AMEND THE ZONING DESIGNATION FOR A NEWLY ANNEXED 20 ACRE PROPERTY, KNOWN AS THE PANTHER RUN ELEMENTARY SCHOOL, TO THE WELLINGTON "COMMUNITY FACLILITIES" DESIGNATION FROM THE PALM BEACH COUNTY "AR" DESIGNATION; LOCATED ON THE NORTH SIDE OF LAKE WORTH ROAD, APPROXIMATELY 0.66 MILE WEST OF STATE ROAD 7, AS MORE
