Gaskets shall be locked-in style.

All fittings for 4" through 8" C900 pipe shall be one-piece injection molded or a combination made from materials meeting ASTM D1784. Installation Instructions




The Series 2800 is designed to restrain C905 PVC pipe bell joints. It consists of one restraint ring with individual actuating wedges to restrain the spigot end of the pipe, and one back up ring that slides onto the pipe and fits behind the pipe bell as an anchor point while the two rings are connected together by an array of connecting thrust rods.



2 Assemble the pipe joint per the pipe manufacturer's instructions.

3 Insert all of the connecting rods through the bolt holes provided and thread the nuts on each of the rods so that several threads show. Do not tighten these at this time.



4 Hand tighten the actuating screws until all wedges are touching the pipe. Continue tightening the screws in an alternating manner until the torque limiting twist-off nuts twist off.

5 Snug all of the nuts on the connecting rods. Make sure that the Series 2800 bell ring bears evenly against the back side of the pipe bell. Do not over tighten the connecting rods as to move the spigot end further into the bell.

- Slide the Series 2800 bell ring along the length of the PVC pipe to fit snugly behind the bell. Slide the Series 2800 restraint ring on the spigot end of the second pipe with the lip facing spigot end of the pipe.




Installation Instructions**



- Slide the spigot restraint onto the end of the pipe with the lip or the wording "This Side Toward Bell" facing the end of the pipe. Do not tighten the restraint wedges at this time.
- Install the backup ring on the fitting bell behind the gasket race as shown. Install the clamp bolts and tighten to 50 ft-lbs. Keeping an equal gap on both sides.
- Assemble the joint according to the manufacturer's instructions.
- Install the thrust bolts. Thread a nut onto each bolt until there are several threads showing.
- Pull the restraint ring away from the joint until the slack is removed from the thrust bolts. Hand tighten the actuating screws on the restraint ring until all wedges are touching the pipe. Continue tightening the screws in an alternating manner until the torque limiting heads twist off. Tighten thrust bolts until evenly snug being careful not to pull the spigot further into the bell.
