VII New Business

- a [PSC-276](#) PALM BEACH COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE DISTRICT 8 WELLINGTON REPORT

Lt. Humphrey greeted the committee. He stated that he would normally jump into the quarterly statistics, but to express how grateful The Palm Beach

County Sheriff's Office is for Palm Beach County Fire Rescue, Florida Highway Patrol. Other responding agencies, Village of Wellington staff and the community for their outpouring support for the tragic loss for three of our heroes.

Lt. Humphrey went on to share the third quarter statistics with the committee. He stated that comparing third quarter to second quarter that they are down in every category.

He shared that they are down 21% in traffic stops and this is due to the tornado response and the dignitary escorts.

He went onto to introduced Deputy Gonzalez and the Therapy Dog unit.

Deputy Gonzalez introduced his partner, K9 Charlie and the other deputies and their K9S. He shared the responsibilities and roles of this unit. He shared that the unit has grown and more deputies and K9s have been added.

He answered questions from the committee.

b [PSC-277](#) PALM BEACH COUNTY FIRE RESCUE REPORT

Captain Vomero greeted the committee and wished everyone a happy holidays. She shared that last quarter Palm Beach County Fire Rescue had a total of 1,753 calls and of those calls 73% were medical

The dispatch handling time was 46 seconds. The average turnout time was 45 seconds, and the average travel time was 5 minutes and 18 seconds which gave an average response time total was 6 minutes 49 seconds.

c [PSC-278](#) PRESENTATION ON A CARDIAC ARREST AND WHOLE BLOOD ADMINISTRATION DEMONSTRATION

Chief Vomero introduced EMS Captain David Cooper who will be presenting the Whole Blood and CPR presentation. Captain Cooper thanked the committee for giving him the opportunity to present this evening. He went on to share his presentation and then held a demonstration with Fire Rescue staff.
