

AN ORDINANCE OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA'S COUNCIL, ADOPTING AN INTERLOCAL SERVICE BOUNDARY AGREEMENT (ISBA) WITH PALM BEACH COUNTY TO COORDINATE FUTURE LAND USE, PUBLIC FACILITIES, AND SERVICES IN ADVANCE OF FUTURE ANNEXATIONS WITHIN THE AREA DEFINED BY THE ISBA; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT; PROVIDING A CONFLICTS CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Municipal Annexation or Contraction Act, Chapter 171, F.S., and the Interlocal Service Boundary Agreement Act, Chapter 171, Part II, F.S., recognize the use of Interlocal Service Boundary Agreements to coordinate future land use, public facilities and services, and protection of natural resources in advance of annexation; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Wellington and Palm Beach County have complied with the procedural requirements contained in Chapter 171, Part II, F.S., and have negotiated an ISBA; and

WHEREAS, the Village Council deems it in the best interest of Wellington to enter into the ISBA with Pam Beach County, attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein; and

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**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF WELLINGTON,
FLORIDA, THAT:**

SECTION 1: The Village of Wellington hereby adopts the Interlocal Service Boundary Agreement with Palm Beach County, which is attached hereto as Exhibit A, and authorizes the Mayor to execute the Agreement.

SECTION 2: The Manager is hereby authorized and directed to transmit the executed ISBA to the Palm Beach County Board of County Commissioners.

SECTION 3: Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance conflict with any section, paragraph, clause, or phrase of any prior Wellington Ordinance, Resolution, or Municipal Code provision, then in that event, the provisions of this Ordinance shall prevail to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 4: Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any portion or part thereof, other than the part to be declared invalid.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption by the Wellington Council upon second reading.
