27 28 29	Sec. 1-2, Definitions and Rules of Construction, is amended to add the following definition in alphabetical order [in strikethrough (deleted) and <u>underlined</u> (added) format]:			
29 30 31 32 33 34 35	 Normal Hours of Operation: the days of the week and time periods when a commercial establishment within 300 feet of residential homes within a residential Planned Unit Development (PUD) is permitted to provide services/goods. Normal Hours of Operation are 7:00 AM to 10:00 PM, Sunday through Thursday, and 7:00 AM to 11:00 PM, Friday and Saturday, or as otherwise stated in the Land Development Regulations (LDR). <u>SECTION 2.</u> Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance conflict with any section, paragraph, clause or phrase of any prior Wellington Ordinance, Resolution, or Municipal Code provision, in that event the provisions of this Ordinance shall prevail to the extent of such conflict.
