**B. Update on the Wellington Aquatics Center**

Eric Juckett provided the board with an update for the Wellington Aquatics Center grand opening event and the activities that will take place that day. He also explained how the event will be completely free. Mr. Juckett also discussed the daily admission fees going forward, new memberships, and transfer of old memberships.

Dr. Falzone and Eric discussed the projected cost recovery for the new facility and the standard across the country.

Joshua Zillmer asked Eric about the projected timeframe of the current pricing structure and whether or not there was an ability to adjust these prices. Eric explained that staff has ability to adjust the pricing as needed and that we attempt to follow along with industry standards.
