The institute for Regional Conservation is requesting an increase to the rates we use for the Invasive Plant Management. The basis for our request to increase our rates is based upon the need to remain ahead of inflation. The previous rates remained constant for three years without an increase.

We are requesting a 6.7 % increase to all our rates. The percent increase is calculated from the Consumer Price Index data obtained from the Bureau of Labor Statistics (http://www.bls.gov/cpi/cpi1998d.htm).
