21	WHEREAS, the adopted and amended FY 2023/2024 Professional Centre Fund
22	budget does not include sufficient revenues or expenditures to fully fund the demolition;

25 26	WHEREAS, the Acme Improvement District has acquired a land parcel formerly
26 27	owned by Corepoint by paying the delinquent assessments on the property; and
28	WHEREAS, the adopted and amended FY 2023/2024 Acme Fund budget does
29	not include sufficient funding for the delinquent property assessments; and
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31	WHEREAS, the Water & Wastewater Utility incurred emergency expenses for a
32	power feed failure in the Membrane Plant; and

43	WHEREAS, the adopted and amended FY 2023/2024 Utilities Fund capital
44	budget did not include funding for the Peaceful Waters project; and

WHEREAS, the adopted and amended FY 2023/2024 capital budget did not include funding for the Lake Worth Road & Isle View Drive Traffic Signal Project; and

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52 **WHEREAS**, fund balances may be assigned and reassigned by the Wellington 53 Village Council; and

55 **WHEREAS**, capital project budgets may be reallocated by the Wellington Village 56 Council; and

57 58 WHEREAS, a Budget Amendment, attached as Exhibit "A", has been prepared in accordance with Section 6 of Wellington's Charter and in compliance with §166.241 (4) 59 60 (c) Florida's Statutes and Article VII, Purchasing Contracts, and Property Management Policies, Section 2-332 of Wellington's Code of Ordinances increasing the General 61 Recreation revenues and expenditures by \$80,000, transferring Unassigned General 62 63 Fund Balance of \$297,000 to the Professional Centre Fund and allocating it to reduced revenues and demolition expenditures; assigning Acme Fund Balance of \$48,000 to 64 65 property assessments expense; increasing the Utilities Fund revenue and expenditure 66 budgets for \$241,000 in insurance proceeds and emergency expense; reallocating \$400,000 in Utility Capital Project budgets from deferred projects to the Peaceful Waters 67 68 Re-dredging Project; and allocating \$650,000 in Road Impact Capital Fund revenue and 69 expense from fund balance, deferred projects, and intergovernmental cost sharing for the Traffic Signal Project; and 70
