Thank you for that information, Liz.

Regarding Mr. Posner’s stating that he does not wish to continue serving except on an emergency basis; since our Code of Ordinances outlines specific criteria for Special

Magistrates that they must be admitted to the Florida Bar for a minimum of five years, be a member in good standing, be willing to serve on a rotational schedule, and be willing to accept compensation.

I don't feel that being available only on an emergency basis satisfies the requirement of being willing to serve on a rotational schedule, which, in my view, implies a consistent and predetermined schedule.

Please let me know if anyone feels different or ok to take to Council with response that he does not wish to be re-appointed.
