Dear Jim and the Village of Wellington,

We have enjoyed our conversations to date and are excited to collaborate with you and the Village regarding the "K-Park" property. Please find enclosed our Letter of Intent that outlines the key business terms of our proposal accompanied by our presentation.

Related Companies was founded over 50 years ago and has grown into the nation's leading development company, focused on delivering the highest standards of art, architecture, design, community impact, and management with a particular focus on public realm and 'placemaking'. With over 100 local employees and over 4,000 employees across its development and management platforms, Related is committed to Palm Beach County and is focused on inclusive growth in the community.
