Campus Safety and Security

- One armed security person on every campus (Police Officers)
- Alyssa's Law emergency alert system (Centegix)
- Single points of entry
 - All exterior gates looked and/or monitored during school hours
 - All visitors should be screened/appointments preferred
- Locked classroom doors while students are present
- Behavioral Threat Management Teams on all campuses
- Active Assailant Training for ALL District employees by Oct. 1
- Emergency Drill Schedule



Current/New Initiatives

- Increased fleet; marked patrol cars on every campus
- Metal Detector Pilot (PBGHS, Seminole Ridge HS, JILHS, PBLHS)
- Hiring/Recruitment (continuation of partnership with local law enforcement jurisdictions)
- School Police Liaisons for campuses without an assigned PBCSDPD officer
- On-going Security Assessments
 - a. Fencing, alarms, cameras, card readers
