

**A PROCLAMATION OF THE VILLAGE COUNCIL  
OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA RECOGNIZING  
HOSANNA KROPP ON WINNING THE STATE  
CHAMPIONSHIP TITLE IN GIRLS WRESTLING**

*WHEREAS, under the direction of Coach Travis Gray, Hosanna Kropp made history for Wellington High School when she won the Girls State Wrestling Championship, as she is her school's first and the county's second athlete to win this title; and*

*WHEREAS, as a member of the all-boy Wellington High School Wrestling Team, Hosanna Kropp, a junior, practices and competes against boys, which helped her to compete and capture the 2018 Championship title at Osceola High School in Kissimmee, Florida in February 2018; and*

*WHEREAS, competing against the State's top female student wrestlers, Hosanna Kropp delivered a solid performance. She went 5-0 in the 132-pound weight division to win the title, pinning four opponents and claiming a 6-1 victory, where she surrendered her only point of the tournament; and*

*WHEREAS, Hosanna Kropp was a state runner-up last year at the event, she is now ranked No. 8 at 127 pounds in USA Wrestling's National Girls High School Wrestling Rankings; and*

*WHEREAS, in recognition of her history making accomplishments and State Championship title, on February 8, 2018, WPEC CBS Channel 12 named Hosanna Kropp "Athlete of the Week."*

*NOW, THEREFORE, the Village Council hereby congratulates and recognizes Hosanna Kropp for winning the Girls Wrestling Championship title in her weight class, and for making Wellington High School, the Village of Wellington and Palm Beach County proud by becoming the first girl at Wellington High School and second in Palm Beach County history to win a State Wrestling Championship.*
