**A RESOLUTION OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA'S COUNCIL
APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND
CLERK TO EXECUTE AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT
WITH PALM BEACH COUNTY SWA TO PROVIDE
BIOSOLID PROCESSING AND RECYCLING ON AN
EMERGENCY BASIS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE
DATE.**

WHEREAS, the Village of Wellington owns, operates and manages the Village's Water Reclamation Facility; and,

WHEREAS, the Utility generates domestic wastewater residuals referred to as Biosolids as a residual of the treatment process, producing an environmentally sound, beneficial reuse product; and,

WHEREAS, the Utility desires to secure an alternate, short-term method to recycle and beneficially reuse the Biosolids produced on an emergency basis in the event the Utility, due to unforeseen circumstances, is unable to process its Biosolids; and,

WHEREAS, the SWA has sufficient capacity to provide such services on an emergency basis as outlined in the attached Interlocal Agreement; and

WHEREAS, such Interlocal Agreement has been prepared and a copy is attached hereto.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY WELLINGTON, FLORIDA'S COUNCIL that:

SECTION 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified as being true and correct.

SECTION 2. The Wellington Council hereby accepts and approves the Interlocal Agreement with Palm Beach County Solid Waste Authority (SWA) for BioSolids Processing and Recycling on an Emergency Basis (attached hereto as Exhibit "A") and hereby authorizes the Mayor and Clerk to execute the Agreement.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
