Jordan Camilleri serves as a JAM Deputy (Juvenile Assessment and Monitoring) with the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office in District 8 – Wellington. Deputy Sheriff Camilleri exemplifies every quality associated with the title of "Top Cop." He is highly professional, dedicated, and effective in his role, consistently distinguishing himself through his service to both the community and the agency.

Deputy Camilleri brings over seven years of experience to the law enforcement profession, including the past four years serving the Wellington community, where he was raised and continues to reside. In May 2024, he was selected as the District 8 JAM Deputy, a role that reflects both his expertise and commitment to youth intervention and community safety.

In his current capacity, Deputy Camilleri is responsible for a wide range of duties, including monitoring court-ordered juvenile probation sanctions; maintaining strong, collaborative relationships with the Department of Juvenile Justice (DJJ), the School Board, and families; and focusing on early intervention and rehabilitation efforts. He ensures the accurate maintenance of documentation and intelligence related to juvenile offenders within the district, while maintaining regular communication with Juvenile Probation Officers (JPOs).

His responsibilities also include conducting curfew checks twice a month, verifying school attendance, reviewing disciplinary referrals, and making timely contact—within 48 hours—of juveniles newly placed on home detention or probation. Additionally, he assists other units throughout the county with juvenile-related cases, follows up with repeat non-probationary youth to confirm appropriate referrals and services have been offered or completed, and executes juvenile pickup orders.

Deputy Camilleri demonstrates a comprehensive understanding of Florida State Statutes as they relate to juveniles, including violations of probation, home detention requirements, contributing to the delinquency of a minor, and harboring a runaway. He also assists the Detective Bureau with juvenile crimes throughout the Village of Wellington.

In 2025, Deputy Camilleri conducted 24 probation compliance checks and made five arrests for violation of probation. He also carried out 14 juvenile arrests for various offenses throughout the Village of Wellington and submitted six warrant requests to the State Attorney's Office. In addition, he assisted the

Detective Bureau in more than 80 investigations and completed over 200 reports documenting his involvement in cases.

Deputy Camilleri demonstrates a genuine passion for investigative excellence, proactive crime suppression, and exceptional service to the youth in our community. The strength of these qualities makes it a privilege to nominate him—without reservation—for an honor he has long embodied and unquestionably earned: the prestigious “Top Cop” award.
