## 1 **ORDINANCE NO. 2024-25** 2 3 ORDINANCE OF WELLINGTON'S COUNCIL AN 4 AMENDING CHAPTER 14, ARTICLE III, DIVISION 1, 5 14-18 (WILDLIFE) OF THE CODE OF 6 ORDINANCES TO CLARIFY THAT LEASHED DOGS ARE 7 ALLOWED CERTAIN WELLINGTON IN PARKS: 8 PROVIDING A CONFLICTS CLAUSE; PROVIDING A 9 SEVERABILITY CLAUSE: AND PROVIDING AN 10 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** 11 12 WHEREAS, the Wellington Council is authorized and empowered to adopt and 13 amend legislation to govern the affairs of its citizens and promote the public health, safety, 14 and welfare of the community; and 15 16 WHEREAS, Chapter 14, Article IIII, Division I, Section 14-18 provides that animals 17 and household pets are prohibited in Wellington parks, except for neighborhood parks and the dog park; and 18 19 20 WHEREAS, the Wellington Town Center was designed to be dog-friendly so that 21 members of the public can walk around outdoors with their leashed dogs, except in areas 22 where dogs are prohibited by posted signage; and 23 24 WHEREAS, the Wellington Council believes that it is in the best interest of the 25 community to amend Section 14-18 to reflect such intent and provide clarity to members 26 of the public who may visit Town Center for community events or otherwise. 27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF WELLINGTON, 28 29 FLORIDA, THAT: 30 **SECTION 1:** Chapter 14, Article III, Division 1, Section 14-18 of the Code of 31 32 Ordinances, Wellington, Florida, is hereby amended to read as follows: 33 34 Sec. 14-18: Wildlife 35 A. "Wildlife creature" means any animal, bird, mammal, reptile, amphibian, fish, or 36 invertebrate. 37 38 39 B. No person shall molest, harm, frighten, kill, net, trap, snare, hunt, chase, shoot or throw or propel missiles, by any means, at any wildlife creature roaming free about 40 41 a park or in captivity, nor shall any person remove or possess the young of any 42 wildlife creature, or the nest or eggs of any wildlife creature, or collect, remove, 43 possess, give away, sell or offer to sell, buy or offer to buy, or accept as a gift any

specimen, dead or alive.

35 36 37 38 39	shall	<b>SECTION 4:</b> Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any portion or part thereof, than the part so declared to be invalid.
