13	establishing a speed detection system in school zones, as provided by Chapter 2023-		
14	174, Laws of Florida; and

16	WHEREAS, section 316.1896(1), Florida Statutes permits a municipality to		
17	authorize a traffic infraction enforcement officer to issue uniform traffic citations for		
18	violations of speed limits within school zones; and		
19			
20	WHEREAS, section 316.1896(6), Florida Statutes requires a uniform traffic		
21	citation to be issued by a traffic infraction enforcement officer by certified mail to the		
22	address of the registered owner of a motor vehicle involved in the violation if payment		
23	has not been made within 30 days after notification of a violation, if the registered owner		
24	has not requested a hearing before the hearing officer, and if the registered owner has		
25	not submitted an affidavit stating that the motor vehicle was, at the time of the violation,		
26	in the care, custody, or control of another person; and

28	WHEREAS, section 316.1896(14)(b) requires a municipality that elects to		
29	authorize traffic infraction enforcement officers to issue uniform traffic citations to		
30	designate by resolution existing staff to serve as the clerk to the local hearing officer;		
31	and		
32	WHEREAS Wallington has through Ordinance No. 2024.14 authorized traffic		
33 34	WHEREAS, Wellington has, through Ordinance No. 2024-14, authorized traffic		
54 35	infraction enforcement officers to issue uniform traffic citations and now wishes to designate existing staff to serve as clerk to the local hearing officer.
