# Chapter 2. ENFORCEMENT BY CODE ENFORCEMENT BOARD AND/OR SPECIAL MASTER 5

6 The Special Magistrates, appointed from time to time by the Wellington Council, 7 shall have the jurisdiction and authority to hear and decide alleged violations of the codes 8 and ordinances enacted by Wellington as provided in Chapter 2, Article V, Code of 9 Ordinances.

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## Chapter 3. OTHER LEGAL REMEDIES

In addition to the penalties and enforcement procedures provided in the Code of
 Ordinances Chapter 2, Article IV, the Wellington Council may institute any lawful
 civil action or proceeding to prevent, restrain, or abate:

#### 17 Section 14.3.1 Unlawful Action

18 The unlawful construction, erection, reconstruction, alteration, rehabilitation, 19 expansion, maintenance or use of any building or structure; or

#### 21 Section 14.3.2 Occupancy

- 22 The occupancy of such building, structure, land, or water; or
- 24 Section 14.3.3 <u>Illegal Use of Premise</u>
  - The illegal act, conduct, business, or use of, in or about such premises.

### 27 Chapter 4. OTHER ADMINISTRATIVE REMEDIES

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#### Section 14.4.1 Cease and Desist Orders

The Planning and Development Services Department shall have the authority to issue cease and desist orders in the form of written official notices given to the owner of the subject building, property, or premises, or to the owner's agent, lessee, tenant, contractor, or to any person using the land, building, or premises where such violation has been committed or shall exist.

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37 Section 14.4.2 Building permits and certificates of occupancy and use is hereby
 38 repealed.
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40 **SECTION 2.** Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this 41 Ordinance conflict with any section, paragraph, clause or phrase of any prior Wellington 42 Ordinance, Resolution, or Municipal Code provision; then in that event the provisions of this 43 Ordinance shall prevail to the extent of such conflict.

45 **SECTION 3.** Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this 46 Ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall 47 not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any portion or part thereof, other than the 48 part so declared to be invalid.
