16 17	WITERAS and Contract provides for a term of and (1) year with Wallington
17 18	<b>WHEREAS</b> , said Contract provides for a term of one (1) year with Wellington having the option to renew the Contract for an additional one (1) year period; and

21	of Corrections will be paid \$57,497.00 annually for the guard and work squad; and

26	WHEREAS, Staff recommends that the Contract between Wellington and the
27	Florida Department of Corrections be approved for a period of one (1) year expiring on
28 29	January 6, 2016 with an option to renew for an additional one (1) year period; and
29 30	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY WELLINGTON, FLORIDA'S

33	<b>SECTION 1.</b> The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified as being true

38	Manager or his Designee to execute said agreement on behalf of Wellington.
