9 <u>SECTION 5:</u> Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this 10 Ordinance conflict with any section, paragraph, clause or phrase of any prior Wellington 11 Ordinance, Resolution, or Municipal Code provision, then in that event the provisions of 12 this Ordinance shall prevail to the extent of such conflict.
