**ADDENDUM NO. TWO**

**PURPOSE:** The purpose of this Addendum/NOTICE is to make changes, additions, deletions, revisions, and clarifications to the (ITB) Invitation to Bid documents for **Annual Drainage Infrastructure Inspection, Cleaning and Repair Contract**. Bidder shall review the Addendum/NOTICE work and requirements in detail and incorporate any effects the Addendum/NOTICE may have in their proposal price.

**Question 1:** It is understood this is a construction service contract. Specifically, the line items are indicative of trenchless construction methods. Since much of this work seems to be underground pipe repair work, can you confirm that a State of Florida Utility & Excavation License is needed to perform this work either as a bidder or subcontractor?

**Response:** The primary contractor should be a General Contractor. If they are the company performing the actual pipe repairs, they should also be a certified underground utility and excavation contractor. If they are going to sub the repair work out, the sub will need to be a certified underground utility and excavation contractor.

**Question 2:** What will be the procedure for obtaining water at each site, and is there a cost associated with the use of the water?

**Response:** Wellington will provide a utility department water meter and back flow preventer. There will be no charge for this.

**Question 3:** Will third party physical samples and testing be required for every CIPP installation?

**Response:** Wellington will determine the sites to be tested, this should not occur more than one out of five liners.

**Question 4:** What are the cost for the NPDS training that will be required?

**Response:** All underground Contractors/Contractors should have Best Management Practices for NPDES in place. This is a local and State requirement.

**Question 5:** Is there a Bid Bond required for this bid? If so, what is the percentage or amount?

**Response:** Payment and performance bonds shall be required for each project over \$200,000, guaranteeing to the Owner the completion and performance of the project covered in this Contract, as well as full payment of all suppliers, material, laborers, or Subcontractors employed pursuant to this Project. The bonds shall be furnished prior to issuance of the Purchase Order for the project and shall remain in effect until the project is complete.

**Question 6:** Does the Village have an anticipated annual budget for this work?

**Response:** We estimate 500,00K to 750,000K per year for the term of the contract.

**Question 7:** Will a spray on lining technology be accepted; for at least some of the larger diameters? (over 60" for instance...)

**Response:** At this time, Wellington will only consider cured in place lining and in some specific cases slip line to be determined by Wellington management.

**Question 8:** For the Slip Lining work, should bidders assume that any slip lining will be performed exclusively in open ended culvert pipes, and that no access pits will be required?

**Response:** This work will only be open ended piping.

**Question 9:** For the slip lining work, should bidders assume that all slip lining work performed will consist of straight pipes sections only, with no need for bends or other fittings?

**Response:** All repairs will be straight piping.

**Question 10:** For the slip lining work, will any work on the ends (referred to in paragraph H of Item 7.0 Explanation of Terms on page 18 of the Advertisement to Bid Document) be paid for on a case by case basis, and therefore bidders should not include and costs for that potential work in the slip lining prices submitted with the Bid?

**Response:** This will be a case by case basis.

**Question 11:** Can bid items be added for access and restoration (allowances) for the CIPP and Slip Lining items?

**Response:** The unit price for all equipment and trucks shall include the operator, mobilization, fuel, oil and all necessary incidental prices with unit cost. Please refer to page 16 of the bid document.

**Question 12:** Is there a minimum finished ID requirement for the slip lining for each of the pipe diameters listed in the bid items 64 – 76?

**Response:** Thickness will be determined by burial depth.

**Question 13:** Will field-fused/welded joint systems be acceptable for the slip lining items?

**Response:** Yes

**Question 14:** Can mobilization Bid Items be added for each of the technologies, since the bidders do not know how many or what the Scope of each work order will be?

**Response:** See response for question 11.

**Question 15:** Can the Owner provide an estimated minimum value per work order release for each type of work?

**Response:** No

**Question 16:** Is mobilization of equipment billed by the hour incidental to that line item? If not please add pay item for equipment mobilization costs.

**ADDENDUM NO. THREE**

**PURPOSE:** The purpose of this Addendum/NOTICE is to make changes, additions, deletions, revisions, and clarifications to the (ITB) Invitation to Bid documents for **Annual Drainage Infrastructure Inspection, Cleaning and Repair Contract**. Bidder shall review the Addendum/NOTICE work and requirements in detail and incorporate any effects the Addendum/NOTICE may have in their proposal price.

**Question 1:** Will the time for mobilizing equipment from the contractors facility to the site be billable at the hourly rates of the equipment items listed in the "Other Services" Bid Items 100 – 111, or only the hours the piece of equipment is utilized on the site?

**Response:** Wellington should only be billed for the hours that equipment is utilized on the job site.

**Question 2:** Can additional equipment items be added to the "Other Services" Bid Items to include CIPP lining equipment; such as (1) the Curing Unit (boiler), (2) the CCTV Truck, and (3) the refrigerated truck to transport liners to the site?

**Response:** The unit price for all equipment and trucks shall include the operator, mobilization, fuel, oil and all necessary incidental prices with unit cost. Please refer to page 16 of the bid document.

**Question 3:** For the TV viewing Bid Items 1, 2, 3; for pipe lining the pipe usually gets televised three times; once at the completion of the cleaning, once immediately prior to installing the liner, and again after the liner installation is complete. Would the Contractor get paid if televised for all three of these inspections; or are the (2) inspections performed as part of the liner installation incidental to those Bid Items?

**Response:** If the camera is utilized in the 3 instances as described above for pipe lining, the contractor will be paid. The only change for this would be in areas where we know we are lining the whole neighborhood because we know the pipes are the same age and failing. We will utilize the camera twice: 1) to Clean and

camera just before liner is installed and 2) use camera once liner is installed to make sure the liner is properly installed.

**Question 4:** For the Bid, can the bidders assume that there will be adequate access to each end of the pipes to be inspected and repaired; and that no extra money should be included for gaining access or for restoration after the work is complete?

**Response:** This is correct.


**Question 5:** Should the bidders include the costs for a Supervisor/Forman, and for Skilled Laborers in their costs for the CIPP and Slip Lining Bid Items, or would they be paid for separately via Bid Items 108 and 109?

**Response:** Yes, cost for those positions should be billed separately per bid items 108 and 109.

**Question 6:** Based upon the response for question 2 of this addendum, are the bidders to include the costs of the Curing (boiler) truck and the refrigerated liner delivery truck in the cost for the CIPP lining Bid Items 77 – 99?

**Response:** This is correct.
