ORDINANCE NO. 2024-21 1 2 AN ORDINANCE OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA'S COUNCIL, AMENDING THE 3 LAND USE & COMMUNITY DESIGN ELEMENT OF WELLINGTON'S 4 COMPREHENSIVE PLAN, (PETITION NUMBER 2024-0003-CPA), TO MODIFY 5 6 TABLE LU&CD 1-1 LAND USE DESIGNATIONS: DENSITY AND INTENSITY; TO MODIFY POLICIES LU&CD 1.3.3, 1.4.1, AND 1.4.2 FOR CONSISTENCY WITH 7 TABLE LU&CD 1-1; PROVIDING A CONFLICTS CLAUSE; PROVIDING A 8 9 SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 10 WHEREAS, Wellington, Florida's Council, pursuant to the authority in Chapter 163, and 11 Chapter 166, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider changes to its 12 Comprehensive Plan; and 13 14 WHEREAS, Wellington desires to adopt an amendment to Table LU&CD 1-1 Land Use 15 Designations: Density and Intensity, along with modifying policies 1.3.3, 1.4.1, and 1.4.2 to achieve 16 and maintain consistency of the Land Use & Community Design Element of Wellington's 17 Comprehensive Plan and Land Development Regulations. Additionally, the amendment furthers the 18 intent of Wellington's current vision and future needs; and 19 20 21 WHEREAS, the amendment does not change the intent of the Land Use & Community 22 Design Element of the Comprehensive Plan; and 23 WHEREAS, the Planning, Zoning and Adjustment Board, sitting as the Local Planning 24 Agency, after notice and public hearing on November 20, 2024, recommended approval of the 25 Comprehensive Plan Amendment to Table LU&CD 1-1 Land Use Designations: Density and 26 Intensity Plan, along with Policies LU&CD 1.3.3 and 1.4.1, with a 7 to 0 vote. The proposed revision 27 to include Policy 1.4.2 was based on a suggestion for clarification from PZAB but was not part of 28 their original review packet; and 29 30 WHEREAS, Wellington's Council has taken the recommendations from the Local Planning 31 32 Agency, along with the Finding of Fact by staff, into consideration for the proposed amendment to the Comprehensive Plan subject to this ordinance; and 33 34 WHEREAS, Wellington's Council, after notice of public hearing, ____ with a ___ to__ 35 vote to transmit this proposed amendment to the Florida Department of Commerce in compliance 36 with the applicable provisions of the Florida Statutes governing amendments to Local 37 Comprehensive Plans. 38 39 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA 40 THAT: 41 42 SECTION 1. The Land Use & Community Design Element, specifically table LU&CD 1-1 43 and policies LU&CD 1.3.3, 1.4.1, and 1.4.2 of Wellington's Comprehensive Plan are hereby 44 amended as provided in Exhibit A. 45 46 47 **SECTION 2.** The Manager is hereby authorized and directed to transmit this Comprehensive Plan Amendment to the Florida Department of Commerce pursuant to Florida 48

Statutes.

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SECTION 3. The Manager is hereby directed to amend the Land Use & Community Design Element of Wellington's Comprehensive Plan as illustrated in Exhibit A and to include the adopted date and ordinance number in accordance with this Ordinance and pursuant to the requirements of Chapter 163, Florida Statutes.

SECTION 4. Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance conflict with any section, paragraph, clause, or phrase of any prior Wellington Ordinance, Resolution, or Municipal Code provision; then in that event, the provisions of this Ordinance shall prevail to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 5. Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any portion or part thereof, other than the part to be declared invalid.

SECTION 6. The effective date of this Comprehensive Plan Amendment shall be 31 days after adoption by Wellington's Council if there has not been a compliance challenge with the Division of Administrative Hearings. If the ordinance is challenged within 30 days after adoption, this Ordinance shall not become effective until the State Land Planning Agency or the Administrative Commission, respectively, issues a final order determining the amendment to be in compliance.
