

*A PROCLAMATION OF
THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA
RECOGNIZING ST. DAVID'S IN THE PINES EPISCOPAL CHURCH
ON ITS 50TH ANNIVERSARY
IN THE VILLAGE OF WELLINGTON*

WHEREAS, St. David's in the Pines Episcopal Church was established in Wellington in 1976 as a mission by a group of dedicated individuals with a vision to create a place of worship, fellowship, and spiritual growth in Wellington. The church grew rapidly and therefore applied for parish status in late 1978. St. David's in the Pines was awarded parish status in May 1979; and

WHEREAS, it is a Church for people of all races, ethnicities, and ages. On April 6, 1980, Prince Charles was welcomed by then Reverend John Mangrum and celebrated Easter Services at St. David's in the Pines; and

WHEREAS, for fifty years, St. David's in the Pines has served as a beacon of faith, hope, and compassion, providing guidance and spiritual support to its members and the surrounding community; and

WHEREAS, the church has reached a significant milestone, celebrating its Golden Jubilee, reflecting half a century of unwavering commitment to its ministry and mission; and

WHEREAS, the congregation of St. David's in the Pines has grown from its humble beginnings to become a vibrant, diverse, and enduring cornerstone of the community; and

WHEREAS, through its various ministries, outreach programs, and fellowship initiatives, St. David's in the Pines has enhanced the quality of life for residents and contributed to the moral fabric of Wellington.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Village Council of Wellington, Florida does hereby recognize St. David's in the Pines Episcopal Church on its 50th Anniversary and commends St. David's for fifty years of spiritual leadership, dedication, and service to God and the community.
