**RESOLUTION NO. R2022-41**

**A RESOLUTION OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA'S COUNCIL  
APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND  
CLERK TO EXECUTE THE LAW ENFORCEMENT  
SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH THE PALM BEACH  
COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT  
SERVICES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, since Incorporation, Wellington has contracted with the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office to provide law enforcement services for the Village of Wellington; and

**WHEREAS**, on August 10, 2021, Council approved the Seventh Addendum to the Law Enforcement Services Agreement (Agreement) effective October 1, 2021, for a period of one (1) year, expiring on September 30, 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, Article 5.2 of the Agreement provides that the total amount due for all law enforcement services for subsequent years shall be based upon the proposed costs submitted by the Sheriff during Wellington's budget process and approved by Wellington's Council; and

**WHEREAS**, the total amount of compensation for the Fiscal Year 2021/2022 was \$10,157,217.00 which reflected 2% increase and adjustments in staffing levels to include the elimination of the Real Time Camera Center Deputy Sheriff position, reclassification of the Criminal Justice Planner to Criminal Intelligence Analyst, the elimination of the K9 and the reclassification of the K9 Deputy to a Deputy Sheriff, for a total increase of \$159,857.00 over the previous year as set forth in the Law Enforcement Services Agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, the total amount of compensation for the Fiscal Year 2022/2023 is \$10,546,818.00 which reflects a staffing adjustment with the prior addition of four (4) crossing guards as well as a 3% increase for a total increase of approximately \$389,600.70 over the previous year, as set forth in the Law Enforcement Services Agreement, attached hereto as Exhibit "A"; and

**WHEREAS**, Staff recommends that the Village Council approve the proposed Law Enforcement Services Agreement between the Village of Wellington and the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY WELLINGTON, FLORIDA'S COUNCIL** that:

**SECTION 1.** The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified as being true and correct.

**SECTION 2.** The Wellington Council hereby approves the Law Enforcement

1 Services Agreement by and between the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office and the  
2 Village of Wellington, attached hereto as Exhibit "A", and hereby authorizes the Mayor  
3 and Clerk to execute the Agreement.
