ORDINANCE NO. 2014-26

AN ORDINANCE OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA'S COUNCIL, AMENDING THE WELLINGTON COMPREHENSIVE PLAN BY ADOPTING A BRIDLE TRAIL MAP IN THE EQUESTRIAN ELEMENT; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT AND SEVERABILITY; AUTHORIZING THE MANAGER TO UPDATE THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 163.3161 et. seq., Florida Statutes (1987) established the Local Government Comprehensive Planning and Land Development Regulation Act; and

WHEREAS, Wellington adopted its Comprehensive Plan on January 19, 1999, by Ordinance No. 99-01, and

WHEREAS, the Wellington Comprehensive Plan is consistent with all state and county requirements; and

WHEREAS, Wellington's bridle trails are an important amenity in the Equestrian Preserve Area and provide safe routes for equestrian riders and their horses; and

WHEREAS, the Wellington Council desires to amend the comprehensive plan to guide and control the future development of Wellington, and to preserve, promote and protect the public health, safety and welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA, THAT:

SECTION 1: The above recitals are true and correct.

SECTION 2: The Equestrian Element of Wellington's Comprehensive Plan is hereby amended as set forth in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof.

SECTION 3: The Manager is hereby directed to update the Comprehensive Plan in accordance with this Ordinance.

SECTION 4: Should any section paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any portion or part thereof, other than the part to be declared invalid.

SECTION 5: Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance conflict with any section, paragraph, clause or phrase of any prior Wellington Ordinance, Resolution, or Municipal Code provision; then in that event the provisions of this Ordinance shall prevail to the extent of such conflict.
