WHEREAS, the Wellington Council is authorized and empowered to adopt and amend legislation to govern the affairs of its citizens and promote the public health, safety, and welfare of the community; and

WHEREAS, Wellington's Council believes it is in the best interest of its community to amend Section 13-3 of the Code of Ordinances to provide an exception to the duration of bulk vegetative waste allowed to be placed on the curb before scheduled pick-up, within Palm Beach Little Ranches.

SECTION 1. Chapter 13 of the Code of Ordinances, OFFENSES AND MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS, ARTICLE I – PROPERTY MAINTENANCE, is amended as follows [in ~~striketrough~~ (deleted) and underlined added format]:

A. *Applicability:* These regulations shall apply to all property within the municipal boundaries of Wellington.

1. All solid waste shall be stored in garbage cans or dumpsters, which shall be maintained in a sanitary manner. Except as provided below, all garbage cans and recycling containers shall be kept indoors or in a portion of the rear or side yard that is screened from view by walls, fences, or hedges. All dumpsters shall be screened and located in a manner approved by Wellington.

- 46 2. Garbage cans and other trash or recycling containers may be placed at the curb no
47 earlier than 6:00 p.m. on the day prior to scheduled pick-up and shall be removed from
48 the curb no later than 11:00 p.m. on the day of pick-up.
49
- 50 3. No owner or tenant shall permit the accumulation of litter, vegetative/yard debris, or
51 trash on any real property or the adjoining public rights-of-way.
52
- 53 4. Vegetative/yard waste and bulk trash may be placed at the curb no earlier than 24
54 hours prior to scheduled pick-up, with the exception of Palm Beach Little Ranches,
55 which may place vegetative/yard debris at the curb up to 72 hours prior to scheduled
56 pick-up. All vegetative/yard waste that is generated by a landscape company shall be
57 removed from the property by the company on the date of service.
58
- 59 5. Garbage, vegetation, recycling containers, vegetative waste, and/or bulk trash shall
60 be placed at the curb for collection only within the boundaries of the originating
61 property, and shall not be placed upon any roadway surface or rights-of-way area in a
62 way that impedes pedestrian or vehicular traffic flow or safety.
63

64 **SECTION 2.** Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance
65 conflict with any section, paragraph, clause, or phrase of any prior Wellington Ordinance,
66 Resolution, or Municipal Code provision, in that event the provisions of this Ordinance shall prevail
67 to the extent of such conflict.

69 **SECTION 3.** Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance be
70 declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity
71 of this Ordinance as a whole, or any portion or part thereof, other than the part so declared to be
72 invalid.

74 **SECTION 4.** This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption of the Village
75 Council following second reading.
