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AN ORDINANCE OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA'S COUNCIL, UPDATING THE WELLINGTON COMPREHENSIVE PLAN BY INCORPORATING THE ANNUAL REVIEW AND REVISIONS TO THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS ELEMENT TO REFLECT THE 2014/2015 THROUGH 2019/2020 FIVE YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN FOR LEVEL OF SERVICE PROJECTS; AND UPDATING THE SCHOOL DISTRICT OF PALM BEACH COUNTY CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT SCHEDULE; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT AND SEVERABILITY; AUTHORIZING THE MANAGER TO UPDATE THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Section 163.3161 et. seq., Florida Statutes (1987) established the Local Government Comprehensive Planning and Land Development Regulation Act; and

WHEREAS, Wellington adopted its Comprehensive Plan on January 19, 1999, by Ordinance No. 99-01, and

WHEREAS, the Wellington Comprehensive Plan is consistent with all state and county requirements; and

WHEREAS, Wellington has conducted an annual review of the Capital Improvements Element of the Comprehensive Plan as required by Section 163.3177(3)(b) of the Florida Statutes, and finds the 5-year schedule maintains consistency with Wellington's 2014/2015 Capital Improvements Budget and maintains the adopted levels of service; and

WHEREAS, the School District of Palm Beach County annual updates and adopts a Capital Improvement Schedule which is included and adopted by reference in the Capital Improvements Element of Wellington's Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Wellington Council desires to adopt the update of the current comprehensive plan to guide and control the future development of Wellington, and to preserve, promote and protect the public health, safety and welfare.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF WELLINGTON,
FLORIDA, THAT:**

SECTION 1: The above recitals are true and correct.

SECTION 2: The Capital Improvements Element of the Wellington Comprehensive Plan is hereby updated as set forth in Exhibit “A” attached hereto and made a part hereof.

1 **SECTION 3:** The Manager is hereby directed to update the Comprehensive Plan
2 in accordance with this Ordinance.

4 **SECTION 4:** Should any section paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this
5 Ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision
6 shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any portion or part thereof,
7 other than the part to be declared invalid.

9 **SECTION 5:** Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this
10 Ordinance conflict with any section, paragraph, clause or phrase of any prior Wellington
11 Ordinance, Resolution, or Municipal Code provision, then in that event the provisions of
12 this Ordinance shall prevail to the extent of such conflict.
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14 **SECTION 6:** The effective date of this plan amendment shall be effective
15 immediately upon adoption.
