RESOLUTION NO. R2019-67

A RESOLUTION OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA'S COUNCIL AUTHORIZING APPROVAL AND ADOPTION OF THE REVISED UNIFIED PALM BEACH COUNTY LOCAL MITIGATION STRATEGY PLAN AS REQUIRED BY THE DISASTER MITIGATION ACT OF 2000; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

 WHEREAS, Palm Beach County and its 38 municipalities have worked together to develop a multi-jurisdictional strategy known as the Unified Local Mitigation Strategy Plan and have participated in the program since its inception in 1000 in order to create a more disaster resistant community; and

 WHEREAS, the Federal Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 was enacted to establish a national disaster hazard mitigation program to reduce the loss of life and property, human suffering, economic disruption and disaster assistance costs resulting from disasters and to assist state, local and Indian tribal governments in implementing effective hazard mitigation measures to ensure the continuation of critical services and facilities after a natural disaster; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000, as a condition for qualifying for and receiving future Federal mitigation assistance funding, requires such governments to have Federal Emergency Management Agency approved hazard mitigation plans in place that identify the natural hazards that could impact their jurisdictions, identify actions and activities to mitigate the effects of those hazards and establish a coordinated process to implement plans; and

WHEREAS, the 2015 revised Unified Local Mitigation Strategy Plan was approved by the Florida Division of Emergency Management and the Federal Emergency Management Agency and adopted by the Board of County Commissioners on December 16, 2014 and adopted by Wellington on January 13, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the 2020 revised Local Mitigation Strategy has been approved by the Florida Division of Emergency Management and the Federal Emergency Management Agency subject to the adoption by the County Board of County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, the LMS Steering Committee recommends the formal adoption of the 2020 Revised Unified Local Mitigation Strategy Plan, including planned future enhancements and modifications described therein, by the County and all 38 participating municipalities.
