AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE COMPREHENSIVE **AGREEMENT** WITH ARCADIA INFRASTRUCTURE LLC. WHOLLY **OWNED** 1. Α SUBSIDIARY OF ARCADIA TOWERS GROUP, LLC FOR THE MARKETING AND LEASE OF PROPERTIES OWNED BY WELLINGTON OR ACME IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEVELOPING, CONSTRUCTING AND MAINTAINING COMMUNICATIONS FACILITIES: AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Wellington received an unsolicited proposal from Arcadia Towers Group, LLC for the marketing and lease of properties owned by the Village of Wellington or its dependent special district, Acme Improvement District, for the purpose of developing, constructing and maintaining communications facilities (the "Proposal"); and

WHEREAS, at its November 9, 2022 Council Meeting, after reviewing the Proposal, Wellington's Council expressed its intent to waive certain requirements under section 255.065, Florida Statutes and to enter into a comprehensive agreement with Arcadia and directed staff to publish a 30-day notice of intent in the Palm Beach Post and the Florida Administrative Register; and

WHEREAS, the 30-day notice period has ended and Wellington has the authority, pursuant to section 255.065, Florida Statutes, to establish a public private partnership with Arcadia Towers Group, LLC, or its wholly owned subsidiary, Arcadia Infrastructure I, LLC, by entering into a comprehensive agreement; and

WHEREAS, the proposed agreement has been reviewed and analyzed by Wellington's outside consultant, who has determined that the proposed agreement is cost-effective (revenue generating) and provides an overall public benefit to Wellington; and

WHEREAS, Wellington's Council finds that the Proposal is financially beneficial, imposes no costs upon Wellington, and is in the best interest of the public; and

WHEREAS, the comprehensive agreement is for a facility that will be owned by Wellington or Acme throughout the term and at the completion, expiration or termination of the comprehensive agreement; and

WHEREAS, the comprehensive agreement includes adequate safeguards to ensure that additional costs or service disruptions are not imposed on the public in the event of a default or cancellation of the comprehensive agreement by Wellington or Acme; and

WHEREAS, the comprehensive agreement has adequate safeguards in place to

1 2 3	ensure that Wellington/Acme or Arcadia Infrastructure I, LLC has the opportunity to add capacity or facilities to the Project to serve predominantly public purposes; and
4 5	WHEREAS, the proposed agreement otherwise meets the requirements of section 255.065(5), Florida Statutes; and
6 7	WHEREAS, the Wellington Council has the authority to enter into the proposed
8	Agreement on its own behalf and on behalf of its dependent special district, Acme
9	Improvement District.
10 11	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY WELLINGTON, FLORIDA'S

14	SECTION 1. The Wellington Mayor is authorized to execute the comprehensive
15	agreement with Arcadia Infrastructure I, LLC on behalf of Wellington and Acme
16	Improvement District.
