



1           **SECTION 2.** Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this  
2 Ordinance conflict with any section, paragraph, clause or phrase of any prior Wellington  
3 Ordinance, Resolution, or Municipal Code provision, then in that event the provisions of this  
4 Ordinance shall prevail to the extent of such conflict.

5  
6           **SECTION 3.** Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this  
7 Ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision shall  
8 not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any portion of part thereof, other than  
9 the part so declared to be invalid.

10  
11           **SECTION 4.** This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption of the  
12 Village Council following second reading.
