FLORIDA'S COUNCIL. 3 AMENDING ARTICLE 6, SECTION 10, RELATED 4 RECREATIONAL VEHICLES (RV) WITHIN THE RUSTIC RANCHES 5 OVERLAY ZONING DISTRICT (RROZD); PROVIDING A CONFLICTS 6 PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE: 7 CLAUSE: PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 8 9 WHEREAS, the Wellington Council, as the governing body, pursuant to the 10 authority vested in it by Chapters 163 and 166 of the Florida Statutes, is authorized and 11 empowered to consider changes to its Land Development Regulations (LDR); and 12 13 WHEREAS, the RROZD was developed by residents and property owners of 14 Rustic Ranches to preserve the unique character of their community and was adopted in 15 2006. These regulations limited the use of Recreational Vehicles (RVs) as a temporary 16 17 residence within Rustic Ranches to only two (2) consecutive weeks per calendar year; and 18 19 20 WHEREAS, the Equestrian Overlay Zoning District (EOZD) regulations were recently amended allowing RVs as temporary residence on properties five (5) acres or 21 more with the issuance of an Equestrian Permit from November through April; and 22 23 24 WHEREAS, it's the desire of the Rustic Ranches residents to utilize RVs as a temporary residence for more than two (2) consecutive weeks. Removing the two (2) 25 26 week limitation of the RROZD, the EOZD regulations would apply; and 27 WHEREAS, the Equestrian Preserve Committee, after notice and a public hearing 28 held on October 22, 2025, recommended approval of the Zoning Text Amendment with a 29 7 - 0 vote; and 30 31 WHEREAS, the Planning, Zoning and Adjustment Board, as the Local Planning 32 33 Agency, after notice and public hearing held on November 19, 2025, recommended approval of the Zoning Text Amendment with a 7 - 0 vote; and 34 35 36 WHEREAS, the Council has taken the recommendations of the Planning, Zoning and Adjustment Board, the Findings of Fact by Wellington staff, and the comments from 37 the public into consideration in adopting the amendments to the LDR that are the subject 38 39 of this ordinance. 40 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF WELLINGTON, 41 42 FLORIDA, THAT: 43 **SECTION 1:** Sec.6.10.6 titled "Recreational Vehicles," is hereby amended as 44

provided below in strikethrough (delete) and Underline (add) format:

Sec. 6.10.6 - Recreational Vehicles Reserved 47 The use of recreational vehicles, travel trailers, campers or similar vehicles as a 48 temporary residence is permitted, but shall not exceed two (2) consecutive weeks 49 during a calendar year. Water and wastewater connections are required and shall 50 comply with Palm Beach County Health Department regulations. 51 52 **SECTION 2:** Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this 53 Ordinance conflict with any section, paragraph, clause or phrase of any prior Wellington 54 Ordinance, Resolution, or Municipal Code provision, then in that event the provisions of 55 this Ordinance shall prevail to the extent of such conflict. 56 57 **SECTION 3:** Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this 58 Ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such decision 59 shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any portion or part thereof, 60 other than the part so declared to be invalid. 61 62 63 **SECTION 4:** This Ordinance shall become effective upon adoption by the Wellington Council following second reading. 64 65 66 67 68 69 70 (The remainder of this page left intentionally blank)
