


## The National Community Survey™ in Wellington

### The NCS™ for Wellington, FL

- 3<sup>rd</sup> time conducting The NCS (previous surveys in 2021 and 2023)
- Survey conducted from May 20<sup>th</sup> July 1<sup>st</sup> 2025
- Mailing approach employed:
  - Probability-based sample of 3,000 randomly selected households
  - 344 total responses received
  - 12% overall response rate
  - Non-probability, open-participation survey: 161 responses
- Results statistically weighted to reflect Wellington overall
- 95% confidence interval with a +/- 5% margin of error




## Facets of Community Livability: Quality




## Facets of Community Livability: Importance




Percent essential or very important






Wellington residents experience a high quality of life.

**About** 

9 in 10

residents gave excellent or good ratings to:

- Wellington as a place to live (90%)
- Overall image or reputation (90%)
- The overall quality of life in Wellington (93%)

## About 9 in 10 residents

- Plan to remain in Wellington for the next five years (87%)
- Would recommend living in Wellington to someone who asked (92%)



#### Please rate how safe or unsafe you feel:












