**RESOLUTION NO. R2026-06**

**A RESOLUTION OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA'S COUNCIL  
APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND  
CLERK TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT FOR ELECTION  
SERVICES WITH THE PALM BEACH COUNTY  
SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS FOR THE 2026 MUNICIPAL  
ELECTION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, Wellington has scheduled a municipal election on March 10, 2026 with the possibility of a second (run-off) election on March 24, 2026, if necessary; and

**WHEREAS**, Wellington desires the Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections' assistance in conducting the municipal election; and

**WHEREAS**, an Agreement in the form attached hereto as Exhibit "A" outlines the responsibilities of each party for conducting the election and provides that Wellington will pay the costs incurred by the Supervisor of Elections' Office associated with conducting Wellington's municipal election; and

**WHEREAS**, the costs of conducting the municipal election without the assistance of the Supervisor of Elections is prohibitive at this time.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY WELLINGTON, FLORIDA'S COUNCIL** that:

**SECTION 1.** The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified.

**SECTION 2.** Wellington's Council hereby approves the Agreement for Vote Processing Equipment Use and Election Services by and between the Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections and Wellington in the form attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and authorizes the Mayor and Clerk to execute the Agreement on behalf of Wellington.

**SECTION 3.** This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
