RESOLUTION NO. R2015-57

A RESOLUTION OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA'S COUNCIL APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE AN AMENDMENT TO THE CONTRACT WITH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS TO PROVIDE FOR THE USE OF INMATE LABOR IN WORK PROGRAMS WITHIN THE WELLINGTON ENVIRONMENTAL PRESERVE AT THE MARJORY STONEMAN DOUGLAS EVERGLADES HABITAT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Corrections and Wellington have negotiated a contract for the use of inmate labor for the maintenance of the Wellington Environmental Preserve at the Marjory Stoneman Douglas Everglades Habitat; and

WHEREAS, said Contract provides for a term of one (1) year with Wellington having the option to renew the Contract for an additional one (1) year period; and

WHEREAS, under the terms of the contract it is anticipated the Department of Corrections will be paid \$57,497.00 annually for the guard and work squad; and

WHEREAS, Council approved entering into the first year of the contract through Resolution R2014-18; and

WHEREAS, Staff recommends that Amendment #1 to the Contract between Wellington and the Florida Department of Corrections be approved for an additional period of one (1) year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY WELLINGTON, FLORIDA'S COUNCIL that:

SECTION 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified.

SECTION 2. The Wellington Council hereby approves the Amendment to the Contract with the Florida Department of Corrections (attached hereto as Exhibit "A") and authorizes the Manager or his Designee to execute said agreement on behalf of Wellington.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
