1 ORDINANCE NO. 2025-25 2 3 AN ORDINANCE OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA'S COUNCIL 4 AMENDING THE CANDIDATE QUALIFYING PERIOD FOR 5 THE 2026 MUNICIPAL ELECTION: PROVIDING A CONFLICTS 6 **CLAUSE: PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY**; 7 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 8 9 WHEREAS, section 9(C) of the Village of Wellington Charter provides that any 10 resident of Wellington who wishes to become a candidate for a Village elected office shall qualify with the Village Clerk no sooner than noon on the last Tuesday in January nor later 11 than noon on the second Tuesday in February of the year in which the election is to be held; 12 13 and 14 WHEREAS, section 100.3605, Florida Statutes, permits the governing body of a 15 16 municipality, by ordinance, to change the dates for qualifying and for the election of members 17 of the governing body of the municipality to provide for the orderly transition of office resulting 18 from such date changes; and 19 20 WHEREAS, the Palm Beach County Supervisor of Elections requires a minimum of 21 95 days prior to an election to prepare, print, and test municipal election ballots and to convert 22 such ballots into an accessible format for persons with disabilities and has requested that 23 municipalities modify their candidate qualifying periods to accommodate this time constraint; 24 and 25 26 WHEREAS, the Wellington Council now desires to modify its qualifying period to 27 accommodate the Supervisor's request. 28 29 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF WELLINGTON, 30 **FLORIDA THAT:** 32 33

SECTION 1: The Village of Wellington hereby amends the candidate qualifying period for the 2026 Municipal Election to run from noon on November 4, 2025 to noon on November 18, 2025.

SECTION 2. Nothing herein is intended to create a permanent change to the Village Charter. Following the candidate qualifying period for the 2026 Municipal Election, municipal election qualifying periods shall thereafter comply with Wellington's Charter.
