REQUEST FOR QUOTES

Tiger Shark Cove Park Light Pole Installation

The Village of Wellington is interested in utilizing the School District of Palm Beach County's Contract #24C-47M for the installation install two (2) existing furnished Musco Lighting poles with five (5) 1,500-watt metal halide light fixtures. As outlined in the contract's Special Conditions Item II, Site Inspection(s), when a potential project exceeds \$10,000, Purchasing will conduct a Request For Quote (RFQ) and include scope of work and any associated plans or prints. The RFQ will be open to only those vendors awarded on the contract.

The contract's Special Conditions Item II, Site Inspection(s) further details. "Following the site inspection, quotations shall be submitted as directed and by the deadline specified. This quotation shall be based on the individual scope of work, bid special conditions, bid specifications and all applicable regulations and codes, and submitted on the Bid Quote-Estimate Sheet."

"There will be no additional charge for consultation or troubleshooting on any particular project. This will be included with any project by the awarded contractor for that project."

A mandatory site inspection will take place on Wednesday, March 12, 2025 at 9:00am at Wellington's Tiger Shark Cove Park located at 13800 Greenbriar Boulevard, Wellington, FL 33414. This will be the only opportunity to visit the site.

Scope of Work

Village of Wellington, Tiger Shark Install Sports Lighting:

- Installation of two (2) existing owner furnished Musco Lighting poles each with five (5) 1500-watt metal halide light fixtures.
- Install owner-supplied lighting, ensuring photometric compliance to meet field requirements.
- Pick up and transport the materials, including poles and light fixtures, from the Wellington storage site to the installation location.
- Purchase two (2) Musco concrete foundations for the existing Musco light poles and install per Musco's standard soils based installation design, (no floating bases or structural steel foundations)
- Furnish and install new conduit, wiring conductors and handholes by means of hand trenching to minimize damage.

- Furnish and install one (1) new circuit breaker in the existing panel to provide power to the two (2) new poles.
- Furnish and install one (1) lighting contactor in the existing Musco Lighting Control Cabinet to control the two (2) new poles, poles will be switched together.
- Furnish any necessary materials (plywood preferred) and labor for the equipment to protect the field and surrounding areas during installation of the poles.
- Provide electrical engineering as required for a no fee permit, (Permit fees to be paid by the Village of Wellington).
- Provide equipment and labor to re-aim fixtures for one (1) night.
- · Provide dumpster for debris disposal as required.

The contractor shall not proceed with project until a written purchase order has been received. The contractor must obtain prior written approval on all costs before the additional work is started. The contractor shall provide a construction work schedule and submit it to the designated contract person. The schedule shall include estimated commencement and completion dates.
