**A RESOLUTION OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA'S COUNCIL
APPROVING A COMMUNITY AESTHETIC FEATURE
AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE VILLAGE OF WELLINGTON AND
THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION; AND
PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, the Village of Wellington seeks to replace a monument sign at the entrance to Wellington on State Road 7 south of Versailles Boulevard that was damaged in an automobile accident; and

WHEREAS, the proposed monument sign would be located on a portion of the right-of-way owned by the Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT"); and

WHEREAS, as part of the permitting process, the FDOT requires Wellington to enter into a Community Aesthetic Feature Agreement ("Agreement") with FDOT; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement provides that Wellington shall fund all costs for the design, installation, and maintenance of the monument sign; and

WHEREAS, the Wellington Council has determined that execution of the Agreement is in the best interest of Wellington and the public because the sign alerts travelers that they are entering into the jurisdictional boundaries of Wellington in an aesthetically pleasing way and also serves to promote economic development and increased tourism in Wellington.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY WELLINGTON, FLORIDA'S COUNCIL
that:

SECTION 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified as being true and correct.

SECTION 2. The Wellington Council hereby accepts and approves the Community Aesthetic Feature Agreement between Wellington and the Florida Department of Transportation and authorizes the Mayor and Clerk to execute the Agreement, which is attached hereto as Exhibit A, on behalf of Wellington.

SECTION 3. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
