**A RESOLUTION OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA'S COUNCIL
APPROVING A POLICY FOR ELECTION SIGNS ON
DESIGNATED PUBLIC PROPERTY OR RIGHTS-OF-WAY;
AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, Article VIII, section 2 of the State constitution and Chapter 166, Florida Statutes provide Wellington the authority to authorize and regulate signs on public property and rights-of-way; and

WHEREAS, Wellington desires to provide opportunities for posting of election signs on certain designated public property or rights-of-way prior to scheduled elections, referendums, or similar activities affecting the residents, businesses, and property owners in the Village of Wellington; and

WHEREAS, the Election Signs on Designated Public Property or Rights-of-way Policy, attached hereto as Exhibit A, provides standards for placement, size, number, materials, duration, and removal of permitted election signs on designated public property or rights-of-way; and

WHEREAS, the Wellington Council has reviewed the Election Signs on Designated Public Property or Rights-of-way Policy, and finds the policy provides appropriate standards for election signs on designated public property or rights-of-way and delegates certain authority to the Village Manager or designee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY WELLINGTON, FLORIDA'S COUNCIL that:

SECTION 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified as being true and correct.

SECTION 2. The Wellington Council hereby adopts the Election Signs on Designated Public Property and Rights-of-way Policy attached hereto as Exhibit A.
