ORDINANCE NO. 2022-24 1 2 3 AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF WELLINGTON, 4 FLORIDA, AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES BY 5 REPEALING CHAPTER 10, TITLED "AMUSEMENTS AND 6 ENTERTAINMENTS" IN ITS ENTIRETY, REPEALING 7 CHAPTER 34, TITLED "MANUFACTURED HOMES AND 8 TRAILERS" IN ITS ENTIRETY, AND REPEALING ALL RESERVED CHAPTERS IN THEIR ENTIRETY; PROVIDING 9 10 A CONFLICTS CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY 11 **CLAUSE**; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 12 13 WHEREAS, the Wellington Council, as the governing body, pursuant to the 14 authority vested in it by Chapter 166, Florida Statutes, and Article VIII, Section 2 of the Florida Constitution, is authorized and empowered to adopt legislation to govern the 15 16 affairs of its citizens; and 17 18 WHEREAS, Wellington adopted its first Code of Ordinances in 1997, shortly after 19 incorporation, and since that time has adopted revisions as necessary to protect the 20 health, safety, and welfare of its citizens; and 21 22 WHEREAS, the current Code of Ordinances spans from Chapter 1 to Chapter 72 23 with several chapters reserved to allow for amendments over time; and 24 25 WHEREAS, Wellington believes it is in the best interest of the community to revise 26 the Code of Ordinances to contain 24 consecutively numbered chapters, remove 27 outdated and unnecessary provisions, and to simplify the provisions set forth therein; and 28 29 WHEREAS, the regulations contained in Chapter 10 of the Code of Ordinances, titled "Amusements and Entertainments" were revised and made part of Wellington's 30 31 Land Development Regulations (LDR) on January 13, 2020, when Wellington adopted 32 Ordinance No. 2020-01 repealing and replacing the LDR in its entirety; and 33 34 WHEREAS, the regulations contained in Chapter 34 of the Code of Ordinances, 35 titled "Manufactured Homes and Trailers" have been revised and incorporated into Chapter 18, titled "Buildings and Building Regulations"; and 36
