3	A RESOLUTION OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA'S COUNCIL
4	APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND
5	CLERK TO EXECUTE THE LAW ENFORCEMENT
6 7	SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH THE PALM BEACH COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT
8	SERVICES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
9	SERVICES, AND TROVIDING AN EITECHVE DATE.

11	WHEREAS, since Incorporation, Wellington has contracted with the Palm Beach
12	County Sheriff's Office to provide law enforcement services for the Village of Wellington;
13	and
14	WHEREAS, on August 10, 2021, Council approved the Seventh Addendum to
15	the Law Enforcement Services Agreement (Agreement) effective October 1, 2021, for a
16	period of one (1) year, expiring on September 30, 2022; and
17	
18	WHEREAS, Article 5.2 of the Agreement provides that the total amount due for
19 20	all law enforcement services for subsequent years shall be based upon the proposed
20 21	costs submitted by the Sheriff during Wellington's budget process and approved by Wellington's Council; and
21	
23	WHEREAS, the total amount of compensation for the Fiscal Year 2021/2022 was
24	\$10,157,217.00 which reflected 2% increase and adjustments in staffing levels to
25	include the elimination of the Real Time Camera Center Deputy Sheriff position,
26	reclassification of the Criminal Justice Planner to Criminal Intelligence Analyst, the
27	elimination of the K9 and the reclassification of the K9 Deputy to a Deputy Sheriff, for a
28	total increase of \$159,857.00 over the previous year as set forth in the Law
29	Enforcement Services Agreement; and
30	WHEREAS, the total amount of compensation for the Fiscal Year 2022/2023 is
31	\$10,546,818.00 which reflects a staffing adjustment with the prior addition of four (4)
32 33	crossing guards as well as a 3% increase for a total increase of approximately \$389,600.70 over the previous year, as set forth in the Law Enforcement Services
33 34	Agreement, attached hereto as Exhibit "A"; and
35	Agreement, attached herete as Exhibit 77, and
36	WHEREAS, Staff recommends that the Village Council approve the proposed
37	Law Enforcement Services Agreement between the Village of Wellington and the Palm
38	Beach County Sheriff's Office.

40	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY WELLINGTON, FLORIDA'S
41	COUNCIL that:
42	<b>CECTION 4</b> The foreneing reside are bereby effirmed and retified as being true
43 44	<b>SECTION 1.</b> The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified as being true
44 45	and correct.
45 46	SECTION 2. The Wellington Council hereby approves the Law Enforcement

Services Agreement by and between the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office and the
Village of Wellington, attached hereto as Exhibit "A", and hereby authorizes the Mayor
and Clerk to execute the Agreement.
<u>SECTION 3</u>. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
