FIRST ADDENDUM TO THE LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICE AGREEMENT SHERIFF RIC L. BRADSHAW AND WELLINGTON

This First Addendum to the Law Enforcement Service Agreement is made by and between The Village of Wellington (hereinafter referred to as "Wellington"), located in Palm Beach County, and Ric L. Bradshaw, Sheriff of Palm Beach County, Florida (hereinafter referred to as "Sheriff"). Wellington and the Sheriff shall hereinafter be referred to as the "Parties."

WHEREAS, the Parties executed a Law Enforcement Service Agreement effective October 01, 2021, (the "Agreement"), by which the Sheriff agreed to perform law enforcement services; and

WHEREAS, the Parties wish to adjust the level of service by adding four (4) School Crossing Guards, convert one (1) Law Enforcement Aide to one (1) Community Service Aide and set forth the consideration for the Second Year of the Contract Term, October 01, 2022 through September 30, 2023.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants herein contained the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, it is agreed upon as follows:

- 1. The level of service and allocations for the term in the Second Year of the Contract Term of this Agreement, that being October 01, 2022 through September 30, 2023, is reflected in revised EXHIBIT A, attached and incorporated as if fully stated herein. Revised Exhibit A hereby replaces former Exhibit A to the Agreement and is effective October 01, 2022.
- 2. In accordance with Article 5, Section 5.2 of the Law Enforcement Service Agreement, Section 5.1 is amended as to the total amount due for services for the period beginning October 01, 2022 through September 30, 2023 as follows: The total cost of personnel and equipment shall be \$10,546,818.00. Monthly payments shall be \$878,901.50.
- 3. Article 5, Section 5.3, regarding additional law enforcement services of the Law Enforcement Service Agreement is amended and shall now read as follows:

Additional law enforcement services as set forth in Article 2, Section 2.1 (E) shall be compensated at the rate of \$100.00 per hour and will be billed by the Sheriff to Wellington on a monthly basis. This rate is subject to annual review and change upon agreement between Wellington and the Sheriff. Alternatively, Wellington may opt to submit an application for an off-duty permit.

4. In all other respects and unless otherwise stated, the terms and conditions of the Agreement, which includes prior Addenda, shall continue unchanged and in full force and effect.
