RESOLUTION NO. 2022-56

**A RESOLUTION OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA'S COUNCIL
ADOPTING A REVISED ALCOHOL RISK MANAGEMENT
POLICY; REPEALING PRIOR RESOLUTIONS RELATING
TO THE ALCOHOL RISK MANAGEMENT POLICY; AND
PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, on June 22, 2004, the Wellington Council adopted Resolution 2004-97, establishing an Alcohol Risk Management Policy that governs the sale, possession, and consumption of alcoholic beverages at parks and recreation facilities owned by Wellington and/or the Acme Improvement District ("Wellington facilities"); and

WHEREAS, the Wellington Council has amended the Alcohol Risk Management Policy over time to encourage the continued use of Wellington facilities for public and private events where alcohol may be served, sold, or consumed in a manner that protects Wellington/Acme as the property owner and permittees as event hosts, while promoting the health, safety, and welfare of event attendees and the surrounding community; and

WHEREAS, Wellington has amended its Code of Ordinances to remove outdated and unnecessary provisions and simplify the provisions set forth therein; and

WHEREAS, Wellington has reviewed its Alcohol Risk Management Policy and determined that it is in the best interest of Wellington to revise the Policy to ensure consistency with the Code of Ordinances and to facilitate the continued use of Wellington facilities for public and private events where alcohol may be served, sold, or consumed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY WELLINGTON, FLORIDA'S COUNCIL that:

SECTION 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified as being true and correct.

SECTION 2. The Wellington Council hereby adopts the revised Alcohol Risk Management Policy for Parks and Recreation Facilities, attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein.

SECTION 3. All prior resolutions relating to the Alcohol Risk Management Policy, including resolutions R2004-97, R2005-146, R2006-37, R2016-33, and R2019-36, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
