

**A PROCLAMATION OF THE  
VILLAGE COUNCIL OF WELLINGTON, FLORIDA  
PROCLAIMING NOVEMBER 9, 2022 AS  
“WORLD WAR II VETERAN MARTIN DENENBERG DAY”  
IN THE VILLAGE OF WELLINGTON**

*WHEREAS, Martin Denenberg was born in Brooklyn, New York on September 1, 1919. He entered the United States Army on April 29, 1944, and was assigned to the U.S. Army 811 Post Engineers;*

*WHEREAS, Martin Denenberg served in Aruba and Puerto Rico and was honorably discharged on January 19, 1946 at Fort Dix, New Jersey; and*

*WHEREAS, for his service, Martin Denenberg was awarded the American Service Medal, the World War II Victory Medal, and the Good Conduct Medal. Thereafter, Martin Denenberg returned home to Brooklyn, New York; and*

*WHEREAS, Martin Denenberg has lived in the Village of Wellington for 32 years; and is a member of a generation of men and women whose bravery and sacrifices put an end to tyranny across the globe; and*

*NOW, THEREFORE, the Village Council of Wellington, Florida does hereby proclaim Wednesday, November 9, 2022 as “World War II Veteran Martin Denenberg Day” in the Village of Wellington, Florida and do hereby call upon every citizen of the Village to pay recognition to Martin Denenberg for his outstanding service and patriotism.*
